Her artistic achievements are mainly focused on the image. "Her photographs show a familiar world subjected to an inescapable evolution in time, landscapes are being altered, people change in their appearances, the similarities of geographical landmarks become superimposed. The notion of identity and its relation to History has become a fundamental aspect, especially in her recent performative installations, in which spectators are invited to take part."
